From the Pastor's Desk...

Love is a very easy virtue to "sell" people on. Unfortunately it is associated with Hallmark Cards, red roses, and "Precious Moment" figurines. Not that any of those things are bad or are unfitting gestures of love. But when today's second reading is proclaimed, it is usually done so at a wedding ceremony or Mass, and we all know what happens to fifty percent of today's marriages. Is it that people don't fully grasp the importance of Paul's writings in the virtue of love or that the virtue (and reading) have become somewhat trivialized?

Love applies to marriage and deep friendship, certainly. But when St. Paul wrote his letter to the Corinthians, he wrote to a community in which blind loyalty, material wealth and success, and personal prestige were seen as more important. Christians in Corinth were too concerned about their own influence, social standing and competitive spirit with one another. Paul tried, in a nice way, to move them away from being jealous, pompous, inflated, rude and selfish in their personal dealings with one another.

Read and listen carefully to what Paul wrote: love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. How many people (and their hopeless situation) do we give up on? Love is nothing less than a virtue which calls for total self-sacrifice, understanding, and forgiveness. And it will last longer than being real smart, popular or influential. Think about it.
