**From the Pastor's Desk....**

There is much discussion in the Church about the shortage of priests available for parish ministry. Many parishes - including our Parishes of St. Philip and Holy Spirit - have come to terms with sharing one priest, one deacon and one religious sister. The transition has in some ways been unwelcome and difficult, but adjustment takes time - for all the parishioners involved as well as for Fr. Arnold, Deacon George and Sister Joan. But, if we rely on the direction of the Spirit and a generous heart - which can come only through faith. Great good can come out of this for both parishes.

**Listen to the Gospel today:** "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." Jesus knew not only that discipleship would come at a high price, but also that - even in His time - a small number of laborers would turn out to produce the harvest of followers for the Gospel.

It is, however, a wonderful thing to reflect on the call of the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965) to all the laity to assume a greater role in their Church. Look about you, and see all the ministries which lay people carry in the Church. We certainly need to ask the owner of the harvest to send more laborers, but we also need to ask God to inspire more people in the pews - YOU - to step forward and do what needs to be done. The most important item on the agenda is for us to live our faith well every day. That includes stepping forward to make sure your parishes - St. Philip and Holy Spirit - remain places of welcome, communities of grace, and the image of Jesus Christ to our neighborhoods.
