## From the Pastor's Desk....

Today is the Second Sunday of Easter, aka Divine Mercy Sunday. Today in Rome, Pope Francis will proclaim as Saints two of his predecessors on the Throne of Peter: Pope St. John XXIII (1958-1963) and Pope St. John Paul II (1978-2005). Both men's lives and ministries are remembered as being crucially important for the modern day Catholic Church in the world.

I remember John XXIII well. He was known as a strong pastoral priest with close ties and understanding of the working class of Italy. He was Pope barely 5 years, yet he gained worldwide recognition when he authored the famous encyclical *Pacem in Terris* (Peace on Earth), addressing the nuclear arms race and the tensions of the Cold War. His greatest gift to the Church, however, was the convocation of the Second Vatican Council in 1962, which reshaped the face of Catholicism with a new liturgy and opening to the world community. He died on June 3, 1963. He had won at the time of his death the hearts of many Catholic and non-Catholics alike around the world.

Most of us probably recall more recent history and the long papacy of John Paul II. He was the first non-Italian Pope (from Poland) in 400 years when elected in 1978. He traveled to over 100 countries during his papacy and survived an assassination attempt on St. Peter's Square in 1981. His spiritual leadership and diplomatic acumen were credited for the largely peaceful collapse of Communist Eastern Europe in the late 1980's. His papacy sought to move the Church to a clearer self-understanding after Vatican II, with the publication of a new Code of Canon Law and the revised Catechism of the Catholic Church. He died on April 2, 2005. May these two saints, both called to lead the Catholic Church during their lifetimes, guide and protect the Church through their intercession before God.
