From the Pastor's Desk...

Gospel accounts about “the apocalypse” or “the end of time” seem very popular with people. The descriptions of end time destruction in nature and the final judgement against evil, with much anguish and hellfire, make for great art and drama. It’s no wonder that many Hollywood producers turn out so many great box office hits, with fearful scenes of destruction and worldwide catastrophe.

With that idea in mind, consider, if you will, an idea in business/employee management. Studies show that many employees are more productive and diligent in their jobs when there is close supervision and oversight of work duties. The same is true when students in the classroom need the oversight of a teacher to do classroom assignments. All that reminds me of a kitchen magnet I have. There is a picture of Jesus on the magnet knocking on the door with the caption: “Look busy...Jesus is coming.”

The end of time, however it may be pictured, ushers in for us the arrival of the Kingdom of God. This is the longed-for fulfilment of God’s promise of salvation. We do not know exactly how it will occur, and as the Gospels tell us, we do not know the date and time. That knowledge is reserved alone to God, the Lord of all time and history.

In the meantime, we should look busy and get to work! St. Paul told the early Christians that they must be about the work of building the kingdom until Jesus comes. Their lives do not consist of “living in idleness,” being “mere busy bodies, not doing any work.” We need to live as faithful disciples and dedicated Christians, realizing that so long as we live, God’s work must truly be our own. This is the vocation of the Christian as we await the end time and the coming of our God.

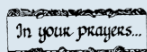

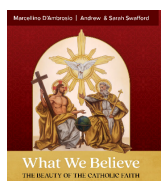

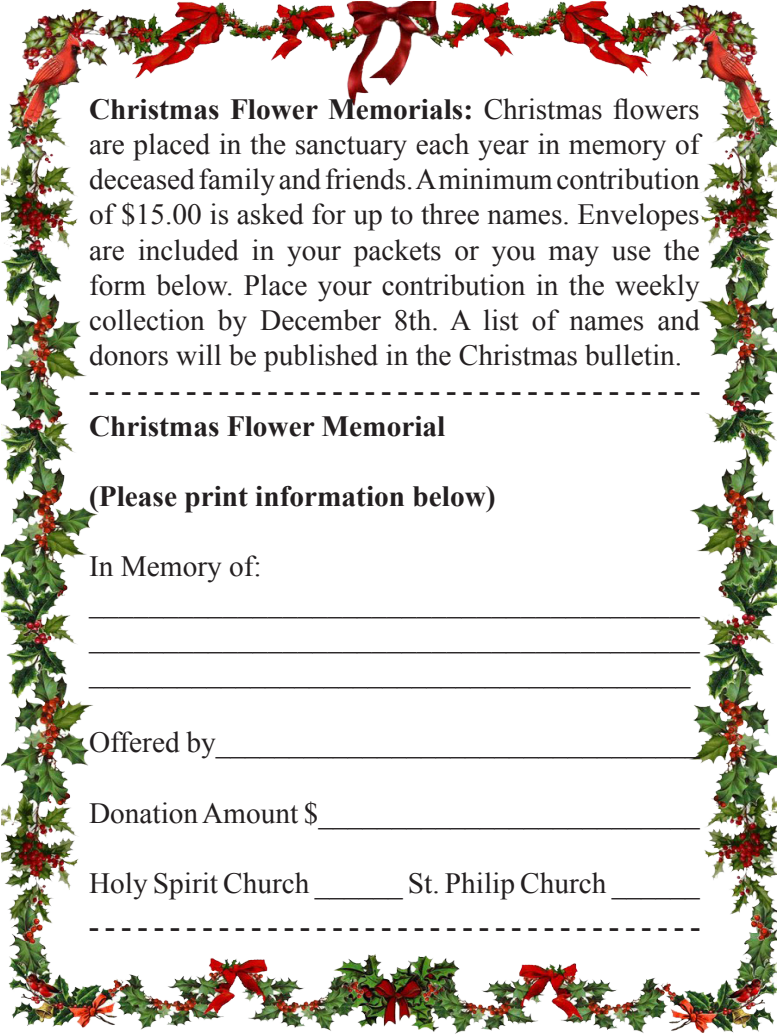
