From the Pastor's Desk...

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus presented a new reason to follow God's commands – not out of fear, but out of absolute love. Remember that when we obey laws and rules out of fear, we do so to avoid punishment and keep ourselves out of trouble. Small children work from this egoistic self-centered perspective. One obeys to avoid punishment and keep people liking oneself.

But love is self-less, self-giving, and places the needs of others before one's own needs. Jesus proclaimed the new law of love in the Gospel, trying to give a higher motive for the law. In today's Gospel, Jesus exhorts His listeners to be perfect – or holy – as the Father is perfect. God loves the good and the bad, the law keepers and the law breakers. God's love for sinners is demonstrated by the rain from heaven falling on the fields of the just and the unjust, the good and the bad.

The law of absolute love commands love of our enemies. The law of love forbids the use of revenge or getting even. The law of love commands generosity and urges believers to view opponents and "haters" as folks who need to experience absolute love. Just imagine the listeners who walked away from Jesus! After all, they hated the Romans, the Samaritans, and the Gentiles! People still walk away from the Gospel for this very reason today. Christians are challenged to form their beliefs based upon love of the "other." Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect!

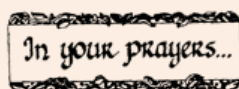

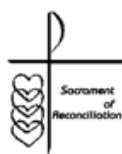
Ash Wednesday is February 22, 2023. Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday. The schedule for Masses and distribution of ashes for that day is as follows:

St. Philip the Apostle	9:00 a.m.
Holy Spirit (with school students)	1:15 p.m.
Holy Spirit	7:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence from meat and fasting for those between the ages of 18-59. The offertory collection on that day is a voluntary offering to support the J.O.I.N. Office, the outreach center of the Church for the needy, in downtown Columbus.

Ash Wednesday Collection: Proceeds of the Ash Wednesday collection will be contributed to the Joint Organization for Inner-city Needs (JOIN). JOIN operates under Catholic Charities of the Columbus Diocese. JOIN provides emergency assistance to the poor and vulnerable throughout the Diocese. This assistance may be in the form of food, personal care or household items and diapers. They also assist with prescriptions, utilities, birth certificates and transportation.

Special Lenten Almsgiving: Again this year, both St. Philip and Holy Spirit Parishes are going to assist the Piarist Fathers in Eastern Kentucky with their outreach needs for the poor of that area. There are few jobs and few Catholics where Fr. Tom Carroll works. (He was our mission speaker in 2018.) The needs there are great, and this will help the Piarist Fathers to assist folks in the local area. This Special Collection will take place at the weekend Masses of Lent.



Penance Service, Sunday, March 5, 2023:

The parish penance service for Lent and the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be on Sunday, March 5, 2023, at 4:00 p.m., at Holy Spirit Parish. The second graders of Holy Spirit School and PSR will make their First Penance that day. Join them in receiving this sacrament before Lent.

Lenten Study Series: Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues

For our 2023 Lenten Study, we will be watching Bishop Robert Barron's presentations on the seven deadly sins, those great spiritual blocks that inhibit our flourishing in relationship with God and one another. Based on Dante's writings, the seven deadly sins correspond to the seven stories of Dante's Mt. Purgatory. Pride, envy, anger, sloth, gluttony, avarice and lust are all presented as patterns of dysfunction within us that lead to unhappiness. Bishop Barron shows us how to counteract these seven sinful patterns through a conscious process of opposition, known as the "seven lively virtues." These offer antidotes to each sin and help set us on the right path to healing and happiness. We will be watching two short presentations each Sunday in Lent followed by a group discussion. 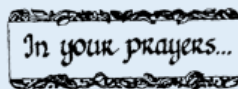

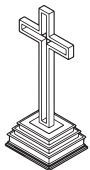
