From the Pastor's Desk...

Today is the day of Easter Joy! Everywhere around the world, this day Christians celebrate the Resurrection of



the Lord. In the Gospel for this Easter night, we hear the angel at the tomb pronounce the words which echo throughout all of history through Christian faith: "Do not be afraid!"

Being a disciple of Christian faith should have profound consequences for our world and, for us – believers in Resurrection. We are uncertain, even fearful in the face of so many tragedies and evil present in the world. Above all, we fear loss – loss of people we love, loss of happiness, and loss of security. The fear of loss forces us to grab for protection, turns us against one another and it even moves us to find substitute "happiness" in a troubled world. This is where we get into trouble – big time.


The loss of their Lord made the disciples recoil and hide, prisoners of fear and worry. They were spellbound by an empty tomb, and only gradually realized that they could never find the Living One among the dead. The Resurrection, which we celebrate today, should have the same impact on us. Christ revealed that death was no longer something to be feared. Time and again during the Easter season, Jesus spoke the words "Do not be afraid" to His disciples. We need to embrace these words today.

In a world shadowed over by death, it is easy to become fearful and hateful of others and events that might harm us. Jesus Christ has cast radiant light over all human history. It is the task of each of us to embrace the light and walk as sons and daughters of light. Should we do so, we release ourselves not only from our substitutes for true happiness, but also are able to see our lives, the world, and all humanity in the light of the Risen Christ.

So many of us have endured great stress these last several years. There is, I grant you, so much to be worried about. But we really, really need to place financial, political, and social problems and worries aside, if only for a few moments. We need to proclaim our greatest belief: Jesus Christ has triumphed over death and all that would harm us! We believe in the power of grace over sin, good over evil, life over death, and light over darkness.



April is Autism Awareness Month: As Catholics, we are called to welcome all persons with disabilities and during the month of April, there is a particular emphasis on persons with Autism, also known as Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Inform Yourself: What is Autism? Autism is a developmental disability that can cause significant social, communication, and behavioral challenges. There is nothing about the physical appearance of a person with Autism that would set them apart from other people. Persons with Autism may learn, behave, react, and communicate in ways that are different than others.

Some persons with Autism need very little or no assistance with their daily living; others require substantial support. The intellectual abilities of persons with Autism can range from gifted to profoundly challenged. Autism affects every person differently, even among siblings who both have Autism.

Catholic parishes should work with persons with Autism, parents, and families, to determine the best way to include each person with Autism in the life of the Church.


Ohio Dominican to Host St. Catherine of Siena Lecture:

Having a Child Baptized? Here at Holy Spirit, we have some helpful guidelines in preparing a family to have their child baptized.

- All parents must attend a Baptism Preparation class. The class is offered on the Third Sunday of every month after the 11:00 a.m. Mass, in the parish office. Preregistration for this class is requested at least one week prior to the class.
- In order to register for the Baptism Preparation Class, the parents must be registered parishioners of Holy Spirit for at least 6 months. If you are not currently registered, we can assist you and register you for an upcoming class.
- Generally, Baptisms take place after 11:00 a.m. Mass on the first and last Sundays of the month. Please note that other children may be baptized on the same day as your child. We do not baptize during the season of Lent. We also do not schedule Baptisms on Sundays that take place near Holy Days or major holidays.
- The Sacrament may be celebrated in English or Spanish. Please understand that a Baptism may be scheduled in another language on the Sunday you desire. Your child's Baptism may need to be scheduled on another Sunday.
