## **From the Pastor's Desk...**

Relationships of all kinds require a great measure of loyalty and faithfulness. A husband and wife must live out every day their strong commitment to each other. The same applies to family members, in spite of any difficulties or disagreements they might have. A true and good friend always “has the back” of the friend. A good employee is strongly loyal to the company and fellow employees.

Relationships bind – they **commit** people to one another. Commitment is in every sense of the word a form of obedience, which observes established norms of fidelity and trust. Nowadays, obeying “commandments” seems to be an optional ingredient in relationships between people and even our relationship with God. Obedience seems outmoded or a violation of personal freedom. “Obedient” is what children should be to parents and teachers.

But what about our relationship to Jesus Christ, who today tells His disciples that if they truly love Him, they will keep His commandments? As He prepares to leave the disciples, Jesus, in the somewhat sad discourse of the Gospel today, assures the disciples He is not leaving them orphaned. But He emphasizes that their love for Him is clearly displayed in their obedience to His commandments. His primary command was that we should “love one another, as I have loved you.”

Obedience – doing what you’ve committed yourself to doing, and being what you said you would be – is what a successful life and a good life is all about. Perhaps the world does not accept this standard, as all of us know numerous people who make all kinds of exceptions to the power of commitment and loyalty. In the reception of the Eucharist – Communion – we belong to Jesus Christ and to one another.

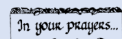
**Feast of the Ascension: Next Sunday.** Every year, parishioners ask me if we are having Mass on “Ascension Thursday” (technically, 40 days after Easter).

In most Dioceses of the United States, (85%), the Ascension of the Lord is celebrated on the Seventh Sunday of Easter, the Sunday before Pentecost. The feast was moved for a variety of reasons, one being the fact that many Catholics have difficulties attending a mandatory weekday Mass.

Because the Ascension celebration is a Feast of the Lord, the observance was moved to a Sunday, because Sunday is the day of the Lord every week (being the day of Resurrection!). The old celebration was scheduled based upon the traditional “40 days” mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (not in the Gospels).

However - that being said - the Ascension is still celebrated on a Thursday in the Archdioceses of Boston, New York, and Philadelphia, and in the state of Nebraska. This change in schedule occurred in most Dioceses about 25 years ago.

## May is Mental Health Month.

According to the National Institute of Health, in a given year about one in four people have a diagnosable mental disorder, such as depression, bi-polar disease, schizophrenia, among others. One in 17 people has a severe mental illness.

Mental illness encompasses biological, psychological, social and spiritual dimensions of the individuals affected. The illness also impacts the lives of the person's family.

Severe mental illness often raises profound questions of faith, such as, "Why does God allow sickness?" or "Why me?" As a faith community, we are called to support individuals and their families through their time of crisis when the illness first occurs, and in the ensuing life and ongoing management of it.

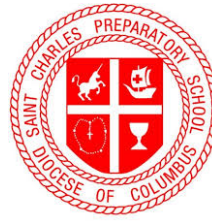
The spiritual dimension is critical to the recovery process. We can offer spiritual comfort through our prayerful presence in people's lives, by acknowledging their pain and supporting them through the healing process.



### Having a Child Baptized?

Here at Holy Spirit, we have some helpful guidelines in preparing a family to have their child baptized.

- All parents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class. The class is offered on the third Sunday of every month after the 11:00 a.m. Mass, in the parish office. Preregistration for this class is requested at least one week prior to the class.
- In order to register for the Baptism Preparation Class, the parents must be registered parishioners of Holy Spirit for at least six months. If you are not currently registered, we can assist you and register you for an upcoming class.
- Generally, Baptisms take place after 11:00 a.m. Mass on the first and last Sundays of the month. Please note that other children may be baptized on the same day as your child. We do not baptize during the season of Lent. We also do not schedule Baptisms on Sundays that take place near Holy Days or major holidays.
- The Sacrament may be celebrated in English or Spanish. Please understand that a Baptism may be scheduled in another language on the Sunday you desire. Your child's Baptism may need to be scheduled on another Sunday.

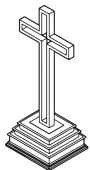
