From the Pastor's Desk...

On this Sunday, "Corpus Christi Sunday," we celebrate our Catholic belief in the true presence of Jesus Christ in the Sacrament of the Altar. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus Christ is truly present – both physically and spiritually – under the sacramental, outward signs of bread and wine.

The Gospel today is a text that actually follows a sign that Jesus performed in John's Gospel – the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. This event, not covered in today's reading, describes Jesus feeding the crowd of five thousand. He saw the huge number of people who had followed Him and needed to eat in a remote place. Jesus satisfied a physical hunger, just as Moses had fed the Israelites in the Sinai wilderness with the manna from heaven.

That story is only a preparation for what we hear today. Jesus states "I am the living bread that came down from heaven." Belief in this declaration requires an act of faith, a total act of recognition of who Jesus is and acceptance of His teaching. We are told the Jews grumbled and quarreled among themselves, challenging how any man could make such a claim.

That is the point. Even in Jesus' time, people were deeply split on His self-claims and His teaching. Our belief in the presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and the meaning of His life in us is an act of faith. Many other Christians dispute this Catholic belief, maintaining that Jesus surely did not intend a literal acceptance of this Gospel teaching. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus Christ is truly present and offers Himself as food for our spiritual life, a life sustained for all time into eternity.

The nourishment with the Bread of Life is the very source of sustenance of our life with Christ. We become what we eat. We are the Body of Christ in the world. We must in turn be Christ for others. Receive this sacrament with the knowledge that for the believer, the reception of this sacrament is lifegiving and life changing!




