**From the Pastor's Desk...**

The early Christian community of the young, newly emerging Church was a Jewish Christian community. Initially, the Gospel was preached just in Jerusalem and the surrounding regions. Matthew's Gospel was written for these Christians – former Jews and not necessarily the Gentiles. This “comfort” passage of Matthew, whom we hear today, was written for them.

Jesus knew, based on the reaction He received, what these new disciples would encounter. Their belief in the Risen Lord made them “Jewish heretics,” as they embraced belief in God become man and the Resurrection. They were being thrown out of the temple and synagogue worship, and their Jewish families were disowning them. They were perceived as a profound threat to civil peace and religious order.

Notice in today's Gospel that Jesus tells them three times “do not be afraid.” Long before the above-mentioned events, Jesus knew they would face persecution. He tells them not to fear those who could do them physical or bodily harm, but only those who could destroy their souls. He told His disciples that God cares for them, more than the numerous sparrows of the sky. He reminds them that they are worth far more than these little birds.

Events of our time can make us fearful or anxious. We face today numerous challenges, but we must remember that we are the sons and daughters of God. We must place our full trust and confidence in God – not in our possessions, our homes, or even our friends. God cares for us, the people who are His own. His providence and care extend to all who place their lives in His hands.

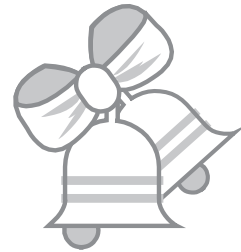



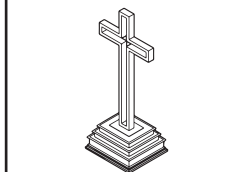
