#### From the Pastor's Desk...

Faithfulness is difficult in any age. It requires remaining faithful to God and His call, even when it seems easier or more logical to set it aside. Being faithful requires trusting in God's promises, even when so many walk away.

The Gospel according to Mark for the First Sunday of Lent is short and sweet. Jesus calls the first witnesses to His ministry to repent, and be faithful to the Gospel. It is the same message spoken to us on Ash Wednesday when the ashes were sprinkled on our heads.

Maintaining faith in times of distress is not easy, and the times we live in tempt us in so many ways to shortchange the call of the Gospel to forgiveness. Many people claim that there are sins that are simply unforgiveable. Yet, faithfulness to the Gospel requires us to always remain committed to the prayer we invoke every time we gather to celebrate the Eucharist: "Heavenly Father.... Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who have sinned against us." This is never easy, but let's remain faithful to our call.

March 22nd. Come and spend some extra time in prayer with Jesus this Lenten season.





#### **Director of Religious Education:**

Holy Spirit Catholic Church is currently looking for a Director of Religious Education. Holy Spirit is a parish community serving Whitehall and the Eastside of Columbus, Ohio. We are a multicultural parish and have a vibrant ministry of outreach in the area. It proclaims the Gospel of Jesus and supports the needs of its diverse community through an array of ministries, liturgies and programs including Holy Spirit Elementary School.

The DRE is responsible for developing and maintaining a parish-based ministry of evangelization and catechesis for children, youth, and adults. The DRE reaches out to families and individuals in the community, provides formal instruction and empowers parishioners to serve one another. The DRE fosters close communication and collaboration with other community organizations and parish ministries, especially Holy Spirit Elementary School. This position is an at-will position and may be terminated by the pastor.

The position of DRE is a full-time, 12 months a year position. The DRE must be a practicing Catholic and in good standing with the church, a knowledgeable person of the faith and doctrines of the Catholic church. The ideal candidate should have a bachelor's degree in education, catechesis, theology or a related field. A master's degree is preferred. Experience in this field is a plus. Fluency in Spanish would be an advantage.


#### GOD IS STILL CALLING


