## From the Pastor's Desk...

From the very beginning of the Gospel of Mark, Jesus' mission was countering the forces of evil in the world: sin, sickness, and death. In last week's Gospel, He healed the Demoniac who screamed out in the synagogue. In today's Gospel, He cures the fever of Simon Peter's mother-in-law. Next week, He makes whole the decaying flesh of the leper. He performs all these works as a sign of the presence of the Kingdom of God. Now is the time, He announced to His listeners, to decide for the Kingdom and work for its fullness in our time and history.

Jesus was clear about His mission. He pursued it with a sense of urgency, telling the disciples today that "for this purpose I have come." Jesus, Mark says, travels about and reaches out to individuals and towns. He goes to them; He doesn't expect people to take the first step and come to Him. In meeting people "where they are," He has perhaps given the Church of today a possible new model of operation.

Pope Francis began his pontificate eight years ago with his call for the Church to be a "field hospital." These centers for urgent medical care are set up on battlefields or behind the lines, to provide for emergency medical needs. Imagine our Church – not our building, but its members, going out to people who are damaged and injured by life. This concept of the Church, says Pope Francis, focuses the ministry of the Church not on itself, but on those in dire need. Those emergency-need situations can take on many forms: poverty and neglect, violence and abuse, isolation, and fear. All of these things damage, destroy, and cripple human life.

Every Catholic, I believe, ought to respond to Francis' call. Think about what Francis has asked of us!

The beginning of Lent is fast approaching. In fact, it is a week from this coming

Wednesday. The schedule for Masses and distribution of ashes for that day is as follows:

Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence from meat and fasting for those between the ages of 18-59. The offertory collection on that day is a voluntary offering to support the J.O.I.N. Office, the outreach center of the Church for the needy, in downtown Columbus.



Ash Wednesday Collection: Proceeds of the Ash Wednesday collection will be contributed to the Joint Organization for Inner-city Needs (JOIN). JOIN operates under Catholic Charities of the Columbus Diocese. JOIN provides

emergency assistance to the poor and vulnerable throughout the Diocese. This assistance may be in the form of food, lifesaving medication, utilities, infant needs, birth certificates, transportation, eyeglasses, burial assistance, senior needs, referrals, personal care/household items and more.

## **Director of Religious Education:**

Holy Spirit Catholic Church is currently looking for a Director of Religious Education. Holy Spirit is a parish community serving Whitehall and the Eastside of Columbus, Ohio. We are a multicultural parish and have a vibrant ministry of outreach in the area. It proclaims the Gospel of Jesus and supports the needs of its diverse community through an array of ministries, liturgies and programs including Holy Spirit Elementary School.

The DRE is responsible for developing and maintaining a parish-based ministry of evangelization and catechesis for children, youth, and adults. The DRE reaches out to families and individuals in the community, provides formal instruction and empowers parishioners to serve one another. The DRE fosters close communication and collaboration with other community organizations and parish ministries, especially Holy Spirit Elementary School. This position is an at-will position and may be terminated by the pastor.

The position of DRE is a full-time, 12 months a year position. The DRE must be a practicing Catholic and in good standing with the church, a knowledgeable person of the faith and doctrines of the Catholic church. The ideal candidate should have a bachelor's degree in education, catechesis, theology or a related field. A master's degree is preferred. Experience in this field is a plus. Fluency in Spanish would be an advantage.


