From the Pastor's Desk...

Today's Gospel contains one of the most famous verses of Scripture, John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that everyone who believes in him might not perish, but might have eternal life." It is good to read that passage and remind ourselves that God loved (and still loves) the world – with all its scars, imperfections, and open wounds.

The world is not the cosmic stage for all evil and its triumph. The world, loved by God, is where all people work out their salvation. Jesus, the Son of God, came into this world and gave us the great gift of God's love. A visible sign of that love is seen in the Cross, and the willingness of Jesus Christ to share our weaknesses, our suffering, and our death.

It is interesting to note that Nicodemus, the Pharisee, came to Jesus, at night, for fear of the Jews. In His conversation, Jesus tells Nicodemus that He (Jesus) is the light come into the darkness of this world and that He wishes all people to come into the light. The guiding image of light, which enlightens the mind and the world, allows us to behold the Cross, the great symbol of God's love for the world. The Cross is the great icon (symbol) of the enormity of God's love for the world. The Cross represents total giving, total sacrifice, total surrender for our sakes.

Director of Religious Education: Holy Spirit Catholic Church is currently looking for a Director of Religious Education. Holy Spirit is a parish community serving Whitehall and the Eastside of Columbus, Ohio. We are a multicultural parish and have a vibrant ministry of outreach in the area. It proclaims the Gospel of Jesus and supports the needs of its diverse community through an array of ministries, liturgies and programs including Holy Spirit Elementary School.

The DRE is responsible for developing and maintaining a parish-based ministry of evangelization and catechesis for children, youth, and adults. The DRE reaches out to families and individuals in the community, provides formal instruction and empowers parishioners to serve one another. The DRE fosters close communication and collaboration with other community organizations and parish ministries, especially Holy Spirit Elementary School. This position is an at-will position and may be terminated by the pastor.

The position of DRE is a full-time, 12 months a year position. The DRE must be a practicing Catholic and in good standing with the church, a knowledgeable person of the faith and doctrines of the Catholic church. The ideal candidate should have a bachelor's degree in education, catechesis, theology or a related field. A master's degree is preferred. Experience in this field is a plus. Fluency in Spanish would be an advantage.




March is Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month. In 2017, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops wrote:


