From the Pastor's Desk...

Everyone discovers the great daily difficulty of living out one's vocation. During Lent, we are reminded by the Gospel that the Christian vocation means living out the task of carrying one's cross, and perhaps, the crosses of others as well. Often, the impression is created that living Christian discipleship involves only experiencing the happiness of life as a blessing from God. Were that the case, life would be easy – and we all know life can be filled with disappointment, heartbreak, and sometimes extremely difficult burdens.

We read in today's second reading from St. Paul that Jesus Christ Himself offered "prayers and supplications and loud cries and tears" to His Father. In those final days before His death, Jesus foresaw the coming end of His ministry on the cross at Jerusalem. He shared fully the human experience of the fear of death and the sense of abandonment and shame Calvary would bring to His disciples. He was being called to understand His coming death as the fulfillment of His mission and vocation He accepted from the Father. Jesus was teaching that life finds its fulfillment and purpose in death. More importantly, He taught what lies beyond death for us.

What is to come? Consider the image of the grain of wheat. When the seed is set into the ground, it becomes something entirely different. Every kind of seed is changed, and transformed, when planted. It produces beautiful flowers, wonderful fruits and vegetables. In a sense, that is the purpose, the vocation of a seed. After our death we attain our true vocation, life with God for all eternity. Then we, too, fulfill the purpose for which God called us to live in this world. All of this life's cares and worries, concerns and problems, are no more. It is a struggle for us as it was for Jesus.

Director of Religious Education: Holy Spirit Catholic Church is currently looking for a Director of Religious Education. Holy Spirit is a parish community serving Whitehall and the Eastside of Columbus, Ohio. We are a multicultural parish and have a vibrant ministry of outreach in the area. It proclaims the Gospel of Jesus and supports the needs of its diverse community through an array of ministries, liturgies and programs including Holy Spirit Elementary School.

The DRE is responsible for developing and maintaining a parish-based ministry of evangelization and catechesis for children, youth, and adults. The DRE reaches out to families and individuals in the community, provides formal instruction and empowers parishioners to serve one another. The DRE fosters close communication and collaboration with other community organizations and parish ministries, especially Holy Spirit Elementary School. This position is an at-will position and may be terminated by the pastor.

The position of DRE is a full-time, 12-months-a-year position. The DRE must be a practicing Catholic and in good standing with the church, a knowledgeable person of the faith and doctrines of the Catholic church. The ideal candidate should have a bachelor's degree in education, catechesis, theology or a related field. A master's degree is preferred. Experience in this field is a plus. Fluency in Spanish would be an advantage.




