From the Pastor's Desk...

The Risen Christ appears once again to the disciples huddled behind locked doors in today's Gospel from St. Luke. They were deeply traumatized by the events of Good Friday and feared greatly for their lives. Jewish and Roman authorities were seeking out any who might have knowledge of the "stolen body" of Jesus of Nazareth. The two disciples, who knew they had spoken with Jesus and recognized Him as He broke the bread with them, recounted their incredible eye witness encounter with the risen Jesus to the assembled disciples. They were confused, dumbfounded and incredulous.

The first utterance of Jesus standing in their midst is "peace be with you." They are startled and terrified. Jesus reassures them that they are not seeing a ghost. He challenges them to believe their own eyes and to touch Him physically. Imagine, if you can, their own sense of confusion and self-doubt. Perhaps they thought that if He (Jesus) was still alive, that He had come back to settle scores – after all, they had abandoned Him on Good Friday. His appearance calls them to move beyond their fears and to understand that He had to die and be raised. Their belief, like ours, needed to be reinforced.

We need to allow our own Easter belief to be strengthened. Peace in our hearts allows us to set aside fear, a fear which can cripple and drain our spiritual and emotional strength. Confidence in the victory of Jesus over the evil present in the world empowers us to live in ways we would never deem possible. We need not fear events in the world or the trials of daily life. We especially need not fear those who preach that God is out to get us for our faults and failures. This is the meaning of the triumph of Christ over all sin and death for all time.




