## From the Pastor's Desk...

We celebrate this weekend the Ascension of the Lord. Since the days of the early Church, disciples of Jesus Christ have sought a definitive answer to the question posed by the disciples in today's first reading. "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" they asked. They were, of course, seeking the reign of God's kingdom, and they have always had definite ideas on what the kingdom should look like. But Jesus tells the disciples, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established..."

Disciples ever since have wondered when the power of God would be established in the world and when Jesus might come back to do just that. What most disciples have failed to understand is that the Resurrection of Jesus Christ has already established the power of God over evil and death in the world. They were to be witnesses of the living Jesus Christ among the Jews (Jerusalem, Judah, and Samaria) and the Gentiles (the ends of the earth). In spite of events in the world as we see them (war, hatred, injustice), disciples are to be witnesses of the new life and power of Jesus Christ. This is the task, and challenge, of faithful believers.

This is the meaning of the Gospel according to Mark from today's Mass. All disciples are to go into the whole world, and be witness of the Resurrection. Some Christians have resorted to handling serpents or drinking poison as "signs" of the power of the Gospel. The real signs we can use to demonstrate the power of God, present here and now, far exceed these dangerous acts. We are to live the power of forgiveness, generosity of heart, love for enemies, care and concern for the "least important" among us. This is our witness. Jesus is, indeed, coming back to establish the fullness of God's kingdom. Let's get busy!

**Parish Council Elections** – Parish Council has been in a suspended status since the beginning of Covid. We would like to reactivate it. To that end, members of the Holy Spirit council are preparing

for Parish Council elections in October. Beginning in June, Parish Council nomination forms will be available in the church. You will be able to nominate yourself or other parishioners.

Parish Council acts in an advisory role to the Pastor. The council investigates, studies, and discusses matters of concern to the parish; forms responses and makes recommendations to the pastor. Our council can have up to twelve (12) elected members. Members must be at least eighteen (18), and be registered and participating members of Holy Spirit Parish. Members are elected to a three (3) year term, except this year half will be a two (2) year term to prevent all members from leaving in the same year. The council meets monthly ten times during the year with the November/December and June/July meetings being combined, plus any special meetings that may be called.

We invite all parishioners to prayerfully consider the role of a Parish Council member and to nominate either yourselves or other parishioners. If you would like more information on the role of Parish Council members, please contact Deacon George Zimmermann through the Parish office.






