From the Pastor's Desk...

To be a whole person, we must have a relationship with our God. We humans do not like being out of relationships with those around us. Think of the worst moments of your life, when you were rejected by someone, when you were cut off from family and friends or felt isolated. We do not even like to go to the movies or out to dinner by ourselves. Why is solitary confinement such a horrible form of punishment? It is because we are in desperate need of union.

Rejection is such an intolerable hurt because we need to be connected. The question why, why this existential drive for union? Why are the best moments when unions occur and the worst when it is absent? Simply the answer is today's feast.

We are made in the image and likeness of God. If God is essentially Communion and relationship, so are we. Humans strive for union with God and with each other. God is all about Father, Son and the Holy Spirit in a relationship. It is the very nature and essence of God to be in a loving and intimate relationship. So also, it is the very nature and essence of human beings to be in a loving and intimate relationship with God, because we are created in His image and likeness.

In our relationship with people, we need to put aside our fears, hatreds, prejudices, and stereotypes to break the walls and barriers that we have created. Trinitarian God is not an abstract doctrine that we adore once a year, but the three persons (one God) in relationship calling us to be in a loving relationship with them and our neighbors.

The Most Holy Trinity





Parish Council Elections – Parish Council has been in a suspended status since the beginning of Covid. We would like to re-activate it. To that end, members of the Holy Spirit

and St. Philip councils are preparing for Parish Council elections in October. Beginning in June, Parish Council nomination forms will be available in the church. You will be able to nominate yourself or other parishioners.

Parish Council acts in an advisory role to the Pastor. The council investigates, studies, and discusses matters of concern to the parish; forms responses and makes recommendations to the pastor. Our council can have up to twelve (12) elected members. Members must be at least eighteen (18), and be registered and participating members of Holy Spirit Parish. Members are elected to a three (3) year term, except this year half will be a two (2) year term to prevent all members from leaving in the same year. The council meets monthly ten times during the year with the Nov/Dec. and June/July meetings being combined, plus any special meetings that may be called.

We invite all parishioners to prayerfully consider the role of a Parish Council member and to nominate either yourselves or other parishioners. If you would like more information on the role of Parish Council members, please contact Deacon George Zimmermann through the Parish office.




Blessings & Talents: We have all received so much from God. Our blessings are not always recognized or

The conditions for receiving the indulgence include all of the following: participating in the pilgrimage, making a sacramental Confession and receiving Holy Communion in the days leading up to or just after the pilgrimage participation, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. The indulgence may be applied to the souls in Purgatory.


