From the Pastor's Desk...

In discussions with many individuals, an issue that often comes up is “personal worthiness.” By that, I mean, one’s own personal worthiness before God. There are a lot of people who do not consider themselves worthy before God – not worthy of God’s blessings or even worthy of God’s forgiveness.

I’m not quite sure where this feeling of “unworthiness” comes from. Perhaps it is lingering personal guilt that holds a person back. Maybe it is people around that person who have talked them down, minimized their personal worth, and eventually they began to believe it. God is not like people – He holds all of us worthy of the call to discipleship while we live. God considers all of us candidates for life with Him.

In today’s Gospel, the disciples are sent out, two by two, to preach the Good News of the kingdom. They possessed no special personal qualifications. These were ordinary men, without education. These early disciples were a rather “mixed bag,” if you will. They were untested and untrained in preaching and teaching, yet these were the people Jesus Christ decided to start with.

Jesus accepted these first disciples as they were. What mattered to Jesus was their willingness to follow Him. Jesus did not measure their confidence or swagger, to see how convincing they might be. And He told them they were not to rely on anything they packed or brought with them; all that stuff did not matter. Above all, they needed to realize that anything they accomplished wasn’t from their talent, drive, or ambition. It was God’s work, and God was working through them. I think we sometimes forget that.

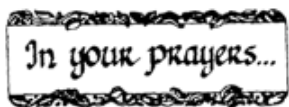

It is a serious situation!




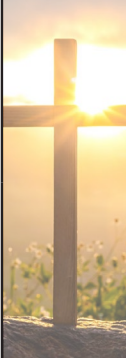
