The Fourteenth Week in Ordinary Time

O God, who in the abasement of Your Son have raised up a fallen world, fill Your faithful with holy joy, for on those You have rescued from slavery to sin You bestow eternal gladness. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God for ever and ever.

From the Pastor's Desk...

In the Gospel this weekend, we hear of Jesus' return to His home village after a period of preaching and working miracles around Galilee. Initially, the people were astonished, and they recognized in Jesus something out of the ordinary, but quickly there was hostility and rejection. People were indignant toward Him. Who does He think He is? We know Him. He grew up among us. He is just the local carpenter. We know His family. He is no different from us.

Today's Gospel suggests that a great obstacle to faith is familiarity; a refusal to believe that God's presence could possibly come to us in so familiar a form as the person next door. We can be like the locals of Nazareth who had fixed ideas as when, where and how the Messiah should come to Israel. The local carpenter, the son of Mary, did not measure up and they really missed out.

We should learn to recognize Christ more and more in the ordinary and the everyday. Can anything good come out of Nazareth? For sure it can! But can we identify the Nazareth in our own selves, in our families, in our community and open the door to heaven in the ordinary, which is the place we would least expect it to be?



Plenary Indulgence

A plenary indulgence is available for any of the Christian faithful participating in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage between May 17 and July 16, 2024. The elderly, infirm, or those who cannot leave their homes for a serious reason, and who participate in spirit with the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, uniting their prayers, pains, or inconveniences with Christ and the pilgrimage, may also receive the indulgence. The conditions for receiving the indulgence include all of the following: participating in the pilgrimage, making a sacramental Confession and receiving Holy Communion in the days leading up to or just after the pilgrimage participation, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. Indulgence may be applied to the souls in purgatory.


